
Park Street's Provision for Learning – Summer Term 2020

On 2nd June 2020, Park Street re-opened for children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 6, critical worker and vulnerable children. Approximately 66% of eligible children returned, rising to over 75% by the end of term, as parents' confidence rose in the safety of the provision.

For children who have been in school: My child and I have felt confident that the school has been a safe place to learn over this period.



Year Six and critical worker/vulnerable Year five children were accommodated at St John's College School, thanks to the generosity of the Headteacher who is a Park Street governor. These children were taught in two classrooms by their teacher and two Park Street teaching assistants, They had access to a large outside space which was made good use of in their video production of 'A Midsummer Night's Dream'.

All the children and parents found this a positive experience, and a useful opportunity for the Year Six children to experience a new learning environment before moving on to secondary school.

Online provision continued, using Teams and Tapestry, for children still learning at home.
