Class one are asking for donations of good quality small cars.



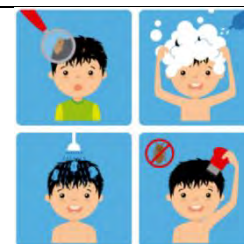
#### SENCO Drop-ins
